## Bath Bomb Kit Starter

Using our ingredients bundle you can make 6-8 70mm bath bombs, using a range of wonderful ingredients, these can be adjusted using all kinds of fragrances and colours on our website to create your own unique Bath Bombs.

Please ensure all appropriate safety gear is worn when making this product.

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You will need the following measurements for this recipe:

- 1kg Bicarbonate of Soda
- 330g Citric Acid
- 70g SLSA Powder
- 40g Strawberry Fragrance
- 10g Pink Mica Powder



- 1. Firstly, prepare and clean your working area. Including sourcing all equipment needed. For this recipe we would recommend a couple of mixing bowls, gloves and a water sprayer.
- 2. Next, in one bowl add your bicarbonate of soda, citric acid and SLSA powder and mix well using your hands. Be careful as SLSA is a very fine powder.
- 3. Then, add in your fragrance oil and mix well. Ensure you break away any lumps that may have formed.
- 4. When you are happy, split your mix into two separate bowls, put one to one side, this will be for your white part of your bombs.
- 5. In the other one, sprinkle in your colour, the amount you use is down to personal preference and how vibrant you want your bath bombs to look. Mix until completely blended.
- 6. Now you need to create the correct consistency for your bath bombs to hold together. From a distance gently spray your bath bomb mix with water, then give it a good stir. You want to create a snowball like feel when you squeeze your mix in your hand. Repeat with both mixtures.
- 7. Once you are happy with the consistency of your mix, you can build your bombs. Here you can experiment with layers to create your finished style. Simply, scoop your mix into your mould, ensuring you use both colours and make one side more heaped than the other. Line up your two halves and press together. Then leave to one side to dry.
- 8. Repeat until all of your mixture is used up, then leave to set. Once dry, you can enjoy your handmade bath bombs!
